



Objective 2 Design Concept:
 Increase levels of deer control and improve access infrastructure to achieve this. Monitor results of reduced deer populations.

Objective 1 Design Concept:
 Prioritise landscape and recreation over production within the context of multi-purpose forestry. Address landscape deficiencies and promote CCF in current and successive rotations. Defer Cobbler path management integration into the LMP until current adjacent crop is mature. Consider detailed path management & access issues in specific recreational plans, but link these with the wider LMP proposals. Use CCF to create forest areas of high landscape & recreational value with lower levels of disruptive intervention. CCF can lead to more interventions at lower intensity, so a balance needs to be struck to prioritise recreational value. Enhance bouldering sites (mainly in North Glen Croe) in consultation with MCS.
