

Junior Squad Training Guidance note (Scotland)

This refers to all (non-motorised) junior sports wishing to access the National Forest Estate for official squad training using a permission for a particular place and time, rather than under the [Scottish Outdoor Access Code](#).

All 5 Regions across Forest Enterprise Scotland have agreed the following:

Where a junior training session is sanctioned by the national governing body in Scotland and applies for permission in accordance with the relevant master agreement, the cost recovery charge will be waived.

This also applies to any vehicle access permit required for the training session. In all other respects, the session will be treated the same as an event, as per the master agreement.

If a key is required for vehicle access, a refundable deposit will still be required.

The event organiser will be issued with an invoice or other notification, clarifying the charge which has been waived. This will enable the organiser, governing body and FES to monitor this in-kind support for the development of youth sport in Scotland.

This guidance will be reviewed annually.
